DECK BUILDING

When building a deck, the key is to find the right balance of gToon cards with high point values and gToon cards with target colors. The black-bordered cards tend to have the highest point values, but they don't count toward your color total. Thus, building a deck full of black-bordered cards means your opponent will probably get the color bonus. Cards with high point values also tend to have no powers.

A wisely chosen selection of lower-valued cards that do have powers, however, can easily build higher totals even without the color bonus.

Silver-bordered cards give you extra flexibility in going for the color bonus, but they tend to have lower point values and can be a handicap unless chosen carefully.

DURING THE GAME

Know which cards are still in the deck and which will give bonuses to the cards in your hand.

For example, you will have to play seven of your original 12 cards, so you should have an idea which three you will play in Round 2 before you pick your cards for Round 1. Don't be afraid to change your strategy if your opponent's cards demand a different
